ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (Loxley Road, Tiddington) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2019

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to revoke paragraph 8(ii) of The Warwickshire County Council (Loxley Road/Stratford Road, Loxley Lane, Knights Lane, Pimlico Lane, Church Lane Alveston, Kissing Tree Lane Alveston, Alveston Hill, Hunscote Lane and Charlecote Road) (50 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2012 and replace it with the wording in the Schedule. The effect will be to reduce the length of road that will be subject to a 50 MPH speed limit.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STRATFORD ROAD, WELLESBOURNE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Stratford Road, Wellesbourne, from a point approx. 29.17 metres from the roundabout, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for works to connect a new water supply.
