

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C31 KINETON ROAD & PILLERTON ROAD, PILLERTON HERSEY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C31 Kineton Road & Pillerton Road, Pillerton Hersey, from Jct. Ford Lane to Jct. Verney Close, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for carriageway patching, 08.00 - 16.00 daily. The Order will commence on 8 October 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 October 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Halford Road, Kineton Road, A422 Banbury Road, A422 Pillerton Hersey Road, Oxhill Road, Tysoe Road, Kineton Road, Bridge Road, Pillerton Road and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ARLESCOTE ROAD, RADWAY, STRATFORD ON AVON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Arlescote Road, Radway, Stratford on Avon, from Jct. B4386 Banbury Road eastwards for approx. 260m, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for the erection of telegraph poles.

The Order will commence on 22 October 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 October 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Arlescote Road, Banbury Road, Camp Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COMMON LANE, CLAVERDON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Common Lane, Claverdon to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for utility works.

The Order will commence on 22 October 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 October 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lye Green, Common Lane, Lye Green Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PENNYFORD LANE, WOOTON WAWEN

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Pennyford Lane, Wooton Wawen, from the Jct. Stratford Road to the entrance to Field Farm, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for overhead cabling and tree cutting.

The Order will commence on 21 October 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 25 October 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Pennyford Lane, Stratford Road, Alcester Road, Wooton Rise (and vice versa).
