ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

BILLESLEY ROAD, UPPER BILLESLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point west of Upper Billesley Farm to the entrance of Olcote.

Reason for Order: To safely allow works on overhead structures.

Order Commences: 25 November 2019 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 25 November 2019.

Access & Diversion: Billesley Road, The Ridgeway, Alcester Road, Stratford Northern Bypass, A46 jct A422 Roundabout, A46 from jct A435 to jct A422 (and vice versa).

CHURCH WALK, WELLESBOURNE

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside property number 13.

Reason for Order: To facilitate works for the installation of polyduct, 08.00 - 17.00 daily.

Order Commences: 12 December 2019 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 18 December 2019.

MORTON BAGOT ROAD, MORTON BAGOT

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the junction with Wootton Wawen Road for a distance of approximately 146 metres.

Order Commences: 9 December 2019 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 15 December 2019.

Access & Diversion: Wootton Wawen Road, Morton Bagot Road, Henley Road, Redditch Road, Oldberrow Road and vice versa.
