ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

LOXLEY ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with the access road to Arden Heath Farm to the junction with Knights Lane.

Reason for Order: To facilitate drainage works.

Order Commences: 25 February 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 16 March 2020.

Access & Diversion: Loxley Road, Tiddington Road, Main Street, Wellesbourne Road, Stratford Road, Wellesbourne Bypass, Staple Hill, Alveston Hill and vice versa.

MAYFIELD AVENUE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside property number 21.

Reason for Order: To facilitate repairs to a foul sewer pipe.

Order Commences: 24 February 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 28 February 2020.

Access & Diversion: Mayfield Avenue, Maidenhead Road, Fordham Avenue, St Marys Road and vice versa.

C45 MAIN STREET (DUFFUS HILL), MORETON MORRELL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Old School Lane for a distance of approximately 30 metres in a southerly direction.

Reason for Order: To facilitate drainage works, 09.30hrs - 15.30hrs daily.

Order Commences: 9 March 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 13 March 2020.

Anticipated Completion: Between 08.00hrs & 16.00hrs on 9 March 2020.
