ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

ALNE HILLS, GREAT ALNE

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside Newlands to a point outside Piper's House.

Reason for Order: To facilitate utility works.

Order Commences: 6 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 10 July 2020.

Access & Diversion: Alne Hills, Sernal Lane, Burford Lane, Sheffield Green Lane, Sheffield Green and vice versa.

GREEN LANE, OXHILL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point 46 metres from the property known as Oakview.

Reason for Order: To facilitate works for a new water connection.

Order Commences: 9 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 13 July 2020.

Access & Diversion: Green Lane, Whatcote Road, Main Street and vice versa.

OLD ROAD, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To facilitate works for the installation of a water pipe.

Order Commences: 6 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 9 July 2020.

Access & Diversion: Old Road, West Street, Church Street, Mill Street, New Street and vice versa.

WELLESBOURNE ROAD, MORETON PADDOX

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Fosse Way to the junction just before Duffus Hill.

Reason for Order: To facilitate utility works.

Order Commences: 6 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 8 July 2020.

Access & Diversion: Wellesbourne Road, Fosse Way, Bowshot Island, Friz Hill, Kineton Road, Staple Hill and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
