ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

VARIOUS ROADS, STRATFORD UPON AVON (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC AND TEMPORARY 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT (NO. 2) ORDER 2020

Temporary 20 mph speed limits on the following roads in Stratford upon Avon

Temporary One-Way traffic flows (with mandatory contra-flow cycle lanes) on the lengths of roads as indicated below

Bridge Street – One-way westbound only along its entire length.

Wood Street – One-way westbound only along its entire length.

Greenhill Street – One-way westbound only along its entire length.

High Street/Chapel Street – One Way southbound only along its entire length.

Sheep Street – One-way westbound only from its junction with Waterside for a distance of 114 metres.

Diversion Route for traffic affected by the One-Way traffic flows – Chestnut Walk, A4390 Grove Road, Arden Street, A3400 Birmingham Road following on to the One-Way system round to Bridge Foot. For the duration of this Notice the provisions of The Warwickshire County Council (Alcester Road, Stratford upon Avon) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 2005 which prohibit vehicles from turning right from Alcester Road into Grove Road are hereby temporarily suspended.

Temporary prohibition of vehicular traffic proceeding in an easterly direction along Alcester Road to proceed onto Greenhill Street, Stratford upon Avon.

Diversion routes for traffic affected – Arden Street, Birmingham Road, Guild Street, Bridge Street and Wood Street OR A4390 Grove Road, Seven Meadows Road, A3400 Shipston Road, Bridge Foot, Guild Street, A3400 Birmingham Road

Prohibition of waiting at any time & no loading/unloading (unless with prior consent of the Council or otherwise indicated by signage) upon the following roads in Stratford upon Avon

Sheep Street – On its northern side along its entire length.

Bridge Street – On both sides along its entire length (includes the suspension of Bus Stops)

High Street – On both sides along its entire length

Chapel Street – Along its entire length on the western side.

Exemptions: will apply to vehicles being used by the emergency services, by local authorities or by statutory undertakers to undertake urgent works in the roads, and to Blue Badge Holders where express permission is given to wait by the Council.

Reason for Order: Because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the Coronavirus Pandemic to enable social distancing measures to be implemented.

Order Commences: 6 July 2020 until the Council is satisfied that social distancing measures on the said roads due to Coronavirus is no longer necessary (the maximum permitted combined duration being 18 months).

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
