ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

(VARIOUS ROADS, STRATFORD UPON AVON TOWN CENTRE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) (NO. 3) ORDER 2020

Road closed to vehicular traffic (11.00am to 6.00pm daily):	High Street (between Bridge Street and Sheep Street) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• An alternative route will be available via Bridge Street, Rother Street, Chestnut Walk and Chapel Street.• Exemptions apply Emergency Services vehicles.
Waiting Restrictions, Parking Places & Taxi Rank:	Bridge Street – no waiting/no loading at any time:- <ul style="list-style-type: none">• South Side, the entire length; and• North Side, from 32 metres east of Union Street, eastwards for a distance of 60 metres. Bridge Street – pay & display parking place 8.00am to 6.00pm daily (max. 1 hour, no return within 2 hours):- <ul style="list-style-type: none">• North side, from 96 metres east of Union Street, eastwards for 30 metres. Union Street – extended taxi rank:- <ul style="list-style-type: none">• East side, from the end of the existing taxi rank, northwards for an additional 22 metres.
Roads closed to vehicular traffic to remove current temporary measures:	The entire lengths of:- Chapel Street; Church Street; High Street and Sheep Street . Alternative routes will be signed and available. The anticipated closure times for the temporary measures to be removed is during the evenings of Monday 17 August and Tuesday 18 August 2020.
Reason for Order: Because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the Coronavirus Pandemic to enable revised social distancing measures to be implemented.	
Order Commences: 14 August 2020 for a period of 18 months, until the Council is satisfied that social distancing measures on the said roads due to Coronavirus is no longer necessary.
