

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C23 RISING LANE & D5057 NETHERWOOD LANE, BADDESLEY CLINTON

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows:

C23 Rising Lane- from its junction with Haywood Lane to its junction with Station Lane,
D5057 Netherwood Lane – from its junction with Rising Lane for a distance of 50 metres in a northerly direction.

Reason for Order: Drainage & carriageway repairs and associated works.
