

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

### (DISTRICT OF STRATFORD ON AVON) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. 06) ORDER 2020

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing District of Stratford on Avon (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below. Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Variation Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at the Stratford on Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford on Avon and at the Public Library, Henley Street, Stratford upon Avon during usual opening hours. #### **Waterside, Stratford-upon-Avon – No Waiting at any time, No Loading at any time**

East side, from its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 29 metres

East side, from a point 49 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 68 metres

East side from a point 126 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 7 metres

East side from a point 209 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 41 metres

East side from a point 256 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 62 metres

West side from its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 290 metres

West side from a point 309 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 10 metres

#### **Waterside, Stratford-upon-Avon – Loading Only**

East side, from a point 29 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 20 metres

East side from a point 133 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 24 metres

#### **Waterside, Stratford-upon-Avon – Disabled Badge Holders Only**

East side from a point 157 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 52 metres

#### **Waterside, Stratford-upon-Avon – No Stopping except buses**

West side from a point 290 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 19 metres
