

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

A429 FOSSE WAY, HALFORD & A429 FOSSE WAY, TREDINGTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from A429/B4455 roundabout to its junction with C49 Halford Road. In addition, a 30mph speed restriction will be imposed between A429/B4455 roundabout and the A429/A3400 roundabout.

Reason for Order: To safely facilitate carriageway resurfacing and associated works, 09.00hrs-15.30hrs.

Order Commences: 26 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 9 December 2020.

Access & Diversion: A429, A422, A439, A3400, A429 and vice versa.

NB: There will be no access to the A429 from adjoining roads whilst works are being carried out.

A429 FOSSE WAY, TREDINGTON

Order Effect: A 40mph speed restriction will be imposed from a point 150m north of jct of D6567 Village Road to a point 5m north of jct of D6573 Blackwell Road.

In addition, a 10mph speed restriction will be effective weekdays only while works are in progress from layby (opp. Electrical Sub Station) in a northerly direction for 3/4km to the camera/parking sign. (managed via signage and convoy vehicles 9.30hrs-15.30hrs).

Reason for Order: For the safety of all road users and of the contractors working on the carriageway.

Order Commences: 30 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 8 December 2020.

C22 NEW ROAD, LOWSONFORD

Order Effect: 13T Weight Restriction, between Preston Road and High Cross Lane.

Reason for Order: To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public and/or damage to the road and bridge structure.

Order Commences: 27 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Access & Diversion: For Vehicles exceeding the 13T Weight Restriction – New Road, Narrow Lane, Back Lane, Shrewley Common, The Cumsey, Lye Green Road, Henley Road, Warwick Road, Edge Lane, Henley Road, Preston Road and vice versa.

ARMSCOTE ROAD, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To facilitate works for new water connections.

Order Commences: 14 December 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 21 December 2020.

Access & Diversion: Armscote Road, Darlingscote Road, Darlingscott Road, Fosse Way, Shipston Road, Halford Road, Ilmington Road and vice versa.

D6640 ST. DENNIS ROAD, HONINGTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Fell Mill Lane to its junction with Brailles Road.

Order Commences: 16 December 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 16 December 2020.

Access & Diversion: Fell Mill Lane, Idlicote Road, Whatcote Road, Vicarage Road, Whatcote Road, Brailles Road and vice versa.

DRAYTON CLOSE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside property number 1 to a point at the side of 93 Drayton Avenue.

Reason for Order: To facilitate new water connections.

Order Commences: 17 December 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 19 December 2020.

MILL LANE, ASTON CANTLOW

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Ford Lane to a point approximately 417 metres from the junction with Wood Lane.

Reason for Order: To safely enable utility works.

Order Commences: 14 December 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 15 December 2020.

Access & Diversion: Mill Lane, Wilmcote Lane, Billesley Road, Wood Lane and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF STRATFORD ON AVON) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. 06) ORDER 2020

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing District of Stratford on Avon (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 4 December 2020.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Waterside, Stratford-upon-Avon – No Waiting at any time, No Loading at any time

East side, from its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 29 metres.

East side, from a point 49 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 68 metres.

East side from a point 126 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 7 metres.

East side from a point 209 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 41 metres.

East side from a point 256 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 62 metres.

West side from its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 290 metres.

West side from a point 309 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 10 metres.

Waterside, Stratford-upon-Avon – Loading Only

East side, from a point 29 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 20 metres.

East side from a point 133 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 24 metres.

Waterside, Stratford-upon-Avon – Disabled Badge Holders Only

East side from a point 157 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 52 metres.

Waterside, Stratford-upon-Avon – No Stopping except buses

West side from a point 290 metres south of its junction with Bridge Street, southwards for 19 metres.
