

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C22 NEW ROAD, LOWSONFORD

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between High Cross Lane and Preston Road.

Reason for Order: Bridge strengthening works, weekdays only.

Order Commences: 6 December 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 10 December 2021.

Access & Diversion: New Road, Mill Lane, Finwood Road, Old Warwick Road, Shrewley Common, Back Lane and vice versa. Access to adjacent properties only.

PUBLIC FOOTPATHS SB34 & SB35 IN THE PARISH OF STRATFORD UPON AVON

Order Effect: Footpaths closed to ALL traffic as follows: SB34 closed between SP20154 53915 and SP 20141 53734. SB35 closed between SP 20154 53915 and SP 20190 53735.

Reason for Order: To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because works are being carried out on or near to the footpaths.

Order Commenced: 12 June 2021 for up to 6 months. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order shall continue in force until **11 June 2022**, or until the works to which it relates are completed or until a Permanent Order has been issued, whichever is the sooner (unless The Secretary of State issues a further direction).
