

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

HENLEY ROAD, PRESTON BAGOT

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Preston Road southwards for a distance of 600 metres.

Reason for Order: To safely enable fibre repairs on overhead structure.

Order Commences: 2 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 2 June 2022.

Access & Diversion: Henley Road, Preston Road, New Road, Narrow Lane, Back Lane, Shrewley Common, The Cumsey, Lye Green Road, The Green, Warwick Road and vice versa.

HONINGTON HALL ROAD, HONNINGTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junction with Idlicote Road and the entrance for All Saints Church.

C53 IDLICOTE ROAD, HONINGTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from Stratford Road to Fell Mill Lane.

Reason for Order: To facilitate bridge refurbishment works.

Order Commences: 16 May 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 17 February 2023.

Access & Diversion: Idlicote Road, Whatcote Road, Halford Road, Fosse Way, Shipston Road, Stratford Road and vice versa. Access will be maintained where possible to adjacent properties only.

NARROW LANE, LOWSONFORD

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point adjacent to Sanbrook Farm.

STRATFORD ROAD, HAMPTON LUCY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Alveston Ford Road and The Spinney.

Reason for Order: To enable essential utility works.

Anticipated Completion: 15 June 2022.

Access & Diversion: Stratford Road, Hatton Bank Lane, Snitterfield Road, Snitterfield Street, Bridge Street, Vine Cottages, Church Street and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF STRATFORD ON AVON) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES & RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION E) ORDER 2022; AND

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF STRATFORD ON AVON) (STRATFORD PARKWAY/PARK & RIDE) (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2022

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:-

- (1) vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Stratford on Avon) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places & Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as varied) to introduce the following:-
 - a. a virtual permit system for all types of parking permit;
 - b. an application process for parking dispensations for vehicles being used to carry out essential works, at cost of £15 per day;
 - c. an application process for parking bay suspensions at a cost of £60 (plus £15 per parking bay per day in a pay & display area); and
 - d. administrative variations.
- (2) vary the existing Off-Street Parking Places for the Parkway/Park & Ride site to introduce a virtual season ticket system and administrative variations.

The Orders commence on Monday 30 May 2022.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose.
