ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C72 LOXLEY ROAD, WELLESBOURNE

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Dovehouse Drive and Loxley Lane.

Reason for Order: Carriageway resurfacing and associated works, 09.00hrs-15.30hrs weekdays only.

Order Commences: 6 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 15 June 2022.

Access & Diversion: Loxley Lane, Stratford Road, A429 Wellesbourne Bypass, Loxley Road and vice versa.

OLD TREE LANE, UPPER TYSOE

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the installation of a new water connection.

Order Commences: 6 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Access & Diversion: Old Tree Lane, Baldwins Lane, Main Street and vice versa.

CHAPEL LANE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point adjacent to the Guild Hall.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the installation of polyethylene cable.

Order Commences: 20 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 22 June 2022.

Access & Diversion: Chapel Lane, Waterside, Sheep Street, Chapel Street and vice versa.

The One-way traffic flow on Chapel Lane will be temporarily suspended to allow access/egress for residents and businesses only.

D6113 PAYTON STREET, D6112 JOHN STREET & D6111 TYLER STREET, STRATFORD ON AVON

Order Effect: The following roads will be closed to vehicular traffic: D6113 Payton Street closed between Warwick Road and Tyler Street, and D6112 John Street closed between Payton Street and Guild Street. In addition, the one-way traffic flow on the following roads will be temporarily suspended: D6111 Tyler Street, D6112 John Street & D6113 Payton Street.

Reason for Order: Closures to enable carriageway resurfacing and associated works, 09.00hrs-15.30hrs. Suspension of One-Way to enable access/egress for residents and businesses whilst works in progress.

Order Commences: 21 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 23 June 2022.

Access & Diversion: One-Way Diversion via A3400, Welcombe Road, St. Gregory's Road, Maidenhead Road, Great William Street, Guild Street, A3400.

D6220 THE WILLOWS & D6220 ST. ANDREWS CRESCENT, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Anticipated Completion: 21 June 2022.
