THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HENLEY-IN-ARDEN TO HOCKLEY HEATH ROAD A3400) (30M.P.H, 40M.P.H AND 50M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) (VARIATION NO.1) ORDER 2023 (HIGH STREET (A3400), BIRMINGHAM ROAD (A3400) AND VARIOUS ROADS, HENLEY IN ARDEN) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

– Impose a 20mph speed limit on the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 1 below.

– Extend the existing 30mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in Schedule 2 below, (replacing 140 metres of the existing 40mph speed limit).
