Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the above-named Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

– Vary the existing District of Stratford on Avon (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, to impose No Waiting at Any Time as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in Schedule 1 below.

– Vary the existing District of Stratford on Avon (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, to impose No Waiting at Any Time as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in Schedule 2 below and No Stopping at Any Time/Clearway briefly described (by approximate measurements) in Schedule 3. Impose a 50mph speed limit on the A4131 Link Road (unnamed) on the lengths described in Schedule 4 below.

– Revoke the 40mph speed limit on the lengths of road described in Schedule 5 below, which will be replaced by a 30mph speed limit by virtue of a system of streetlighting and to reimpose the 40mph speed limit on the length of road described in Schedule 6 below; and

– To vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Luddington Road and Stannells Close, Stratford-Upon-Avon) (40 m.p.h Speed Limit) Order 1993 (which covers Luddington Road and what is now Luddington Close), to reflect the changes in road layout made since the road was realigned, as described in Schedule 7 below.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in Schedules 1 and 2 below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

SCHEDULE 1

(NO WAITING AT ANY TIME)

Luddington Close, Stratford on Avon

From its junction with the B439 Evesham Road, in a southerly direction for its whole length, a distance of 88m, along the western kerb line only. Also, from the southernmost kerb line of Luddington Close, in a northerly direction to the northern property boundary of Osbourne House, a distance of 10m, along the eastern kerb line only.

B439 Evesham Road, Stratford on Avon

From a point in line with the western property boundary of No 109, in a south west, then southerly direction into Luddington Close, a distance of 26m, along the southern kerb line only.

SCHEDULE 2

(NO WAITING AT ANY TIME)

A4131 Link Road, Stratford on Avon

From a point 17m south of the property frontages known as 10 to 16 Evesham Road (B439) on their southern side, then in a northerly and north westerly direction to a point 20m southeast of the centre point of the of the first traffic island north of the roundabout junction with the B439 Evesham Road. A distance of 373m.

SCHEDULE 3

(NO STOPPING EXCEPT IN AN EMERGENCY/CLEARWAY)

A4131 Link Road, Stratford on Avon

From a point 25m south from the centre of the roundabout Junction with the A422 in a southerly/south easterly direction for a distance of 1026 metres.

SCHEDULE 4

(50MPH SPEED LIMIT)

A4131 Link Road, Stratford on Avon

From a point 25m south from the centre of the roundabout Junction with the A422 in a southerly/south easterly direction for a distance of 1026 metres.

SCHEDULE 5

REVOCATION OF 40MPH SPEED LIMIT TO BE REPLACED WITH 30MPH BY VIRTUE OF STREETLIGHTING

B439 Evesham Road, Stratford on Avon

From a point in line with the eastern property boundary of No 12 Evesham Road, then in a westerly direction for a distance of 127m.

Luddington Close (Formerly Luddington Road) Stratford on Avon

From a point 5m south of the southern property boundary of Orchard House, then in a northerly direction for a distance of 48m.

SCHEDULE 6

EXISTING 40MPH TO CONTINUE

B439 Evesham Road, Stratford on Avon

From a point 127 metres west of the eastern property boundary of No. 12 Evesham Road then in a westerly direction for 608m.

SCHEDULE 7

40MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER (TO REFLECT ROAD LAYOUT CHANGES)

Luddington Road (New Layout from Roundabout Junction with the B439 Evesham Road, Stratford on Avon)

From a point 70 metres south from the centre of its roundabout junction with the B439/Evesham Road in a southerly and south westerly direction for 1794m.
