

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C67 EVESHAM ROAD, CRANHILL

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 46A NOTICE OF INCREASE OF ON-STREET PARKING CHARGES

Notice is hereby given that Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under section 46A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, has resolved to vary the charges for on-street parking within the Borough/Districts of Rugby, Stratford-upon-Avon and Warwick, as outlined in the Schedule below. The new charges will come into force on 1 March 2024.

The current charges were prescribed in the following Orders (as varied by s46A notices from time to time):

- The Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017.
- The Warwickshire County Council (District of Stratford on Avon) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017.
