

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KNIGHTS LANE, TIDDINGTON) (30 & 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

(LOXLEY ROAD/STRATFORD ROAD, LOXLEY LANE, KNIGHTS LANE, PIMLICO LANE, CHURCH LANE ALVESTON, KISSING TREE LANE ALVESTON, ALVESTON HILL, HUNSCOTE LANE AND CHARLECOTE ROAD) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (ORDER 2012) (VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to replace the existing 50 mph speed limit with 40 mph and 30 mph speed limits on the lengths of road described in Schedules 1 and 2 below.

SCHEDULE 1 (Proposed 40mph Speed Limit)

Knights Lane, Tiddington
From its junction with Loxley Road, northwards to a point 17 metres south of its centreline junction with Townsend Road.

SCHEDULE 2 (Proposed 30 mph Speed Limit)

Knights Lane, Tiddington
From the centreline of its junction with Townsend Road, southwards for a distance of 17 metres (to the first street lighting column where the 30 mph speed limit then continues by virtue of street lighting).
