

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

### **D5124 CASTLE CLOSE, HENLEY IN ARDEN**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on the lengths of road within Stratford-upon-Avon as described in the Schedule below.
