APPLICATION FOR A VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE TO BE GRANTED UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003

The applicant proposes to make the following variations to their premises licence: Our current licence states in Annex 2: "Beer and wine may be sold on the premises subject to the following condition; Any sale authorised by consent (of the licence) shall take place only when the building is in use for the performance of a play (as defined in the Theatres Act 1968) and not a film show or other performance or activity of any kind"

We would like to make a minor change to this current condition so that alcohol can be retailed as an ancillary to performances inclusive of but not exhaustive to, for dance, spoken word, theatre, comedy, suitable circus performance, cabaret, live music, films, and exhibitions. We will also be available for private hire for events where alcohol will be sold. Worcester Arts Workshop is a community arts centre, in a 4 floor building including a small underground Studio Theatre and a small enclosed courtyard to the front bordering the street. Alcohol will be retailed at ground level in the cafe/bar and in the underground Theatre Vault bar, for consumption on the premises only, indoors and outdoors."
