**Designation of the Riverside
Conservation Area**

Notice is hereby given that on the 7th May 2020, Worcester City Council under powers conferred to them by Section 69 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, revised the Riverside Conservation Area.

The revised Riverside Conservation Area now includes the following properties and their curtilage: Northwick House, Old Northwick Lane; Nimrod House and 2-16 (even) Park View Terrace; Chacewater House and 10 Chacewater Avenue; and 95 Park Avenue.

The Riverside Conservation Area now excludes the following properties and their curtilage: Nos. 15-23 Tower Road, Barbourne; the industrial units A, B, 10 and Midwest Landscaping Ltd Weir Lane; and properties at Dace Road, Tench Close, Rudd Close, Chubb Close, Carp Close and Pike Close.
